Notes

1. **White space:** The white space on the schedule denote unscheduled times to: continue working on assignments; take a break; have questions answered by teaching assistants; work on long-term projects; learn a poem; practice an instrument, math facts, spelling words, vocabulary for Spanish; etc.
2. **Optional After School Activity:** Each day (Monday-Friday), an optional After School activity will be posted. One day a week (as noted on the above schedules), this activity will be synchronous.
3. **“Nightly” reading:** This can occur during the designated block, at any point during an unscheduled time, or in the evening before bed.
4. **Lunch Bunch:** Lunch Bunch is an optional time for students to socialize by grade once a week over lunch with a Maret adult. Children find joy spending time with their classmates, chatting, telling jokes and riddles, playing games, and even having a short dance party.
5. **Fun Frog Finish:** Fun Frog Finish is an optional activity scheduled once a week for each grade. The children will play games, move around, and enjoy the company of their classmates to finish their school day in an energetic and exciting way.
6. **Assembly:** Each week will close with all-Lower School assembly. All children are expected to attend.
7. **Spanish Office Hours:** Sra Delgado and Sra Núñez will have times when you can see them to ask questions or spend a bit more time working on new material.
